The meeting was called to order and the following business was transacted:

Ordered: that Mr. Griffin purchase an air conditioner for the office used by the Social Security Agency in County Hall.

Ordered: that the statement to E. L. Williamson for legal services rendered to the Board of Elections be paid upon the receipt of a bill signed by the Chairman of the Board of Elections.

Ordered: that Mr. Griffin be allowed to hire an extra worker for 90 days to work in the Tax Collector's Office.

Ordered: that Mr. Griffin check over the roof on the building storing the County's radio equipment in Whiteville and make the necessary repairs.

Ordered: that the following releases be made upon the recommendation of the Tax Supervisor: that the tax listed in the name of Edward Dean Lewis, Whiteville Township, be released \$5.10 for the year 1972 due to a clerical error.







BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of Columbus County endorse and support the proposed changes in State taxes on A. B. C. Stores whereby more funds would remain for distribution in the localities paying the taxes and further benefits would be derived on the local level.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be sent to the N. C. Association of County Commissioners, Mr. C. M. Love, and Representatives and the Senator representing Columbus County in Raleigh.

Members of the Chadbourn and Lake Waccamaw Rescue Squads were present and asked for County funds, if any were available, to help support their respective Squads. A motion was made by Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Commissioner Burns and passed to give each of the two Squads present \$4,000.00 each for the FY 1972-73, to be appropriated out of Surplus.

Mrs. Wright asked for improvements to be made in office space formerly used by SENCland and now assigned to Social Services Dept. She and Mr. Griffin are to get an estimate of the cost and present to the Board before any work is done.

Mr. Rhone Anderson appeared before the Board and discussed tentative plans and asked for permission to operate a private landfill for Solid Waste Disposal in Columbus County. A motion was passed to allow Mr. Anderson to present an alternate plan for Columbus County to the Board for study and investigation.

BE IT RESOLVED that the motion heretofore passed at the meeting of the Board on May 5, 1972 be sent to the State Department of Health, with a copy of the Plan for Solid Waste Disposal for Columbus County, as follows: "Mr. Beverly Paul, Executive Director of C. O. G., presented a plan that could be used by Columbus County in implementing the Solid Waste Program in Columbus County. After a discussion with other interested departments, a motion was passed unanimously that the plan be presented to the State Department of Health by Mr. Paul as the plan for Columbus County."

Mr. Belton Blackmon, Chief of Police, Brunswick, appeared before the Board to ask for funds for the operation of the Brunswick Ambulance Service. No action was taken on this request at this time, but a decision will be made at the next meeting.

Ordered: that the following letter be delivered to the Tax Collector and a copy attached to these minutes:

To the Tax Collector of Columbus County:

You are hereby authorized, empowered, and commanded to collect the taxes set forth in the tax records filed in the office of the Tax Supervisor and in the tax receipts herewith delivered to you, in the amounts and from the taxpayers likewise therein set forth. Such taxes are hereby declared to be a first lien upon all real property of the respective taxpayers in the County of Columbus, and this order shall be full and sufficient authority to direct, require, and enable you to levy on and sell any real property of such taxpayers, for and on account therefor, in accordance with law.

The following resolution was passed upon motion made by Commissioner Watts, seconded by Commissioner Johnson:

WHEREAS, Columbus County, a Municipal Corporation, and a Body Politic, holds a lien against Adeline Guion, single, a lien for money paid to her through the Social Services Department, and commonly known as a welfare payment, and said Columbus County, as provided by law, as set forth in the General Statutes of N. C., acquired a lien on the real estate of the said Adeline Guion, and being that certain lien docketed against Adeline Guion, in Old Age Lien Docket No. 1, at page 162, in the office of the Clerk of the Superior Court of Columbus County; and

WHEREAS, the Farmers Home Administration, better known as FHA, a Federal Agency of the United States of America, as agreed to do some repair work on the dwelling on the premises hereinafter described, and in order to do so it must have a subordination release from the said Columbus County, N. C., subordinating its claim or lien to the lien to be acquired by FHA, as aforesaid; and

WHEREAS, the said Columbus County has agreed to subordinate its claim, or lien, against Adeline Guion, to that of the FHA;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and for the purpose aforesaid, and the further consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) paid by the Farmers Home Administration to the said Columbus County, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said Columbus County, through its designated officers of said Columbus County Board of Commissioners, has subordinated, and by these presents does hereby subordinate its lien, as against the said Adeline Guion, to the instrument of security executed by the said Adeline Guion to the Farmers Home Administration, and in so far as the lien to be executed by the said Adeline Guion to the FHA, the said Columbus County does hereby subordinate its lien or claim against the said Adeline Guion, for said purpose, in and to the following described lot or parcel of land in Chadbourn Township, Columbus County, North Carolina:

Beginning at a pine stump in the north margin of the public road leading from Chadbourn to Broadway, and runs near North to a stake; thence near West to a stake; thence an Eastward course about 25 yards to the beginning, containing one-fourth ($\frac{1}{4}$) of an acre, more or less and being the same property wherein the said Adeline Guion is a co-tenant with James Guion, both being heirs at law of Emma Guion, deceased, and being the same property deeded to Jack Guion and wife, Emma Guion as recorded in Book No. 119, Page 278, Columbus County Registry.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said lot and premises, together with all rights, privileges and appurtenances, to the said FHA, free and discharged from all claims or liens of the said Columbus County, above or ahead of the said FHA, for any money or claim owing to it by the said Adeline Guion, for money advanced to her by Columbus County in the past, and any claim or lien of said Columbus County is hereby subordinated to any lien of said FHA.
