RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE PRESENT TOBACCO PROGRAM IN COLUMBUS COUNTY

WHEREAS, it has comt to the attention of the Columbus County Board of County Commissioners that there is the possibility of termimation of the flue cured tobacco allotment system and/or increasing the quotas of flue cured tobacco; and

WHEREAS, flue cured tobacco is such an intricate part of the economy of Columbus County; and

WHEREAS, the farmers of Columbus County have in the past overwhelmingly voted for the continuation of the allotment system; and

WHEREAS, the tobacco farmers are continuously burdened with additional cost of production; and

WHEREAS, they are overwhelmingly in favor of the present government controls and against any increase in tobacco quotas,;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Columbus County and they do respectfully request that the tobacco allotment system remain intact and that there be no increase granted for the crop year of 1974-75, and that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the North Carolina Secretary of AGriculture, the United States Secretary of Agriculture, the United States Senators of North Carolina, and the North CArolina Congressional Delegation.
