**Agenda Item #5: BOARD MINUTES APPROVAL:**

Vice Chairman Bullard made a motion to approve the August 19, 2013 Regular Session Board Meeting Minutes, as recorded, seconded by Commissioner McKenzie. The motion unanimously passed.

**Agenda Item #6: PUBLIC INPUT:**

Chairman McDowell opened the floor for public input. The following spoke.

**Robert Eguene Adams, 233 Mt. Calvary Road, Clarkton, NC 28433:** stated the following:

1. The Feasibility Study that was presented to the Board is the most inclusive information that I have heard on the water system in a long time;
2. This study covers just about all the information that you need to cover this County and to be able to grow the system and the people in this County to get along with each other, and to get along with the people that run this County;
3. The dollars spent for this study were well spent;
4. When the engineering was done for Water Districts II and III, the engineer stated in Water District III, there were not enough houses to justify a water system;
5. I hope this Board allows the professionals do their job in getting this accomplished;
6. I would like to thank you for allowing this company to do this study; **and**
7. I would like for you to consider the citizens that are on limited incomes in this County.

**Agenda Item #7: SHERIFF - APPROVAL to ACCEPT QUOTE for FIVE (5) 2014 DODGE CHARGERS:**

Sheriff Batten requested Board approval to accept the quote for five (5) 2014 Dodge Chargers at \$23,148.74, as per the State Contract pricing. **(This item was tabled at the August 19, 2013 Board Meeting.)**

Commissioner Byrd made a motion to accept the quote for five (5) 2014 Dodge Chargers at \$23,148.74, as per the State Contract pricing, seconded by Commissioner Prevatte. The motion unanimously passed.

**Agenda Item #8: ELECTIONS - DEPARTMENTAL UPDATE:**

Carla Strickland, Elections Director, delivered the following departmental update to the Board.

1. We went through the re-districting process that took place back in December, January and February, and went forward with our candidate filing process;
2. We had a mandatory re-cap that took place for the General Election or during the presidential election this past year with an extremely high voter turnout this past year, particularly in our one-stops;
3. Our voting equipment is under a five (5) year contract, and, at this time, the price is frozen in time;
4. We have went through a wellness check;
5. The passage of House Bill 589 which is now forty-nine (49) pages long involves the following:
  - Voter Identification;
  - Voter reform:
    - Absentee returns - two (2) signatures and ability to be notarized
    - Presidential Preference Primary outside of May Primary
    - Straight Party Ticket (January 01, 2014) will not be on the primary ballot
6. We did a cost analysis on the One-Stop sites in April;
7. We knew the HAVA Funding would be eliminated which we have been receiving approximately \$600,000;
8. The cost per voter ranges from \$56.00 down to \$1.00;
9. House Bill 589 has reduced the one-stop voting days from seventeen (17) days to ten (10)

- days, but we have to operate the same amount of hours cumulatively;
10. There are two (2) Board of Elections members here tonight, namely David McPherson and the new Board member, Harold Fipps;
  11. We were informed by the State Board of Elections that we need to update all of our computers to Windows 7 which will incur additional costs that will be unfunded by the State;
  12. The additional training will be well above the normal cost this year;
  13. The early voting will be an expense of the County this upcoming year;
  14. You can no longer register to vote and vote on the same day;
  15. Pre-registration for sixteen (16) year olds has ceased;
  16. We are getting ready for our municipal election;
  17. This is Citizens Awareness Month; **and**
  18. We have two (2) new employees, namely, William Matthew Gore, Senior Elections Specialist and Katherine Lacey Hooks, Elections Specialist.

Commissioner Prevatte is requesting Board approval and adoption of the following National Alcohol and Drug Addiction Recovery Month September Proclamation.

**NATIONAL ALCOHOL and DRUG ADDICTION RECOVERY MONTH SEPTEMBER PROCLAMATION**

**WHEREAS**, treatment and recovery improve the community's welfare and provide a renewed outlook on life for those who struggle with substance use disorders and their family and friends; **and**

**WHEREAS**, recent studies show that 23.2 million people aged 12 or older in the United States needed treatment for a substance use disorder in 2007, and 5.4 million adults also suffered from a concurrent mental illness; **and**

**WHEREAS**, additional studies have indicated that 8.9 percent of people who made an effort to get treatment, but did not receive it, were concerned that receiving treatment might cause neighbors or community members to have negative opinions of them. However, most say they would not have a negative opinion of a relative or friend in recovery from an addiction; **and**

**WHEREAS**, resources exist online and in our community to increase people's awareness about how substance use disorders affect children, families, and our society; **and**

**WHEREAS**, such education is essential to overcoming misconceptions and achieving long-term recovery; **and**

**WHEREAS**, to help achieve this goal, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration, the White House Office of National Drug Control Policy, and **Columbus County Board of Commissioners** invite all residents of Columbus County to participate in the recognition of "*National Alcohol and Drug Addiction Recovery Month*".
