#### **PUBLIC HEARING OPENED:**

- 3. It is best to bring this before the public and the Board of Commissioners for consideration.

Commissioner Burroughs: Will this mean an increase in the number of employees?

Gary Lanier: they have not told me of an increase of employees.

#### **DISCUSSION/QUESTIONS:**

The following discussion was conducted:

- 1. The present market value of the beaver hide is \$8.00;
- 2. No surrounding counties to Columbus County has a beaver bounty;
- 3. Martin County and Currituck County do have a beaver bounty;
- 4. Can the trapper negotiate a ten and 00/100 (\$10.00) dollars increase per beaver with the landowner?;
- 5. There are sixteen (16) trappers on the list at this time, and we would like to add more;
- 6. We did not collect as many beavers last year due to excessive rainfall; and
- 7. The paperwork involved could lead to the number of trappers participating.

Chairman Byrd stated that he did not support the increase of the beaver bounty from forty and 00/100 (\$40.00) dollars, to fifty and 00/100 (\$50.00) dollars.

Commissioner Bullard made a motion to leave the forty and 00/100 (\$40.00) dollars beaver

bounty as it is, seconded by Commissioner McKenzie. The motion unanimously passed.
