

Changes are coming to Medicaid, FNS, and WIC benefits.

TAKE STEPS NOW.

The federal COVID-19 Public Health Emergency ends May 11, 2023. Your benefits could change. Take action to keep your information up to date.

- **MEDICAID** recertifications (renewals) began April 1, 2023 and continue through April 30, 2024, based on the beneficiary's renewal date.
- In **WIC**, certain types of milk, yogurt, and bread/rolls will be more limited after Aug. 1, 2023.
- Report changes in expenses/income to **FNS** to make sure your benefits are correct.

1 UPDATE YOUR INFO

Medicaid: Visit epass.nc.gov or call your local DSS.

FNS: Contact your local DSS office, ncdhhs.gov/localDSS

WIC: Contact your local WIC agency, ncdhhs.gov/localWIC

2 LOOK OUT

Check for official mail, email, or texts with instructions on when and how to renew coverage or benefits.

3 REPLY ASAP

Respond right away with updated information. Submit forms by the due date.



HAVE QUESTIONS ABOUT MEDICAID RECERTIFICATION? Learn more at medicaid.ncdhhs.gov/renew. Medicaid eligibility will expand when the budget is enacted. We don't know the exact timing.
