Notice of Candidate filing Stay Lifted

The court order temporarily suspending candidate filing for legislative and congressional contests was lifted last night. Absent further instruction from the courts, the county boards should file legislative candidates when filing opens today (Tuesday) morning. The State Board will likewise file congressional candidates.

Absent further instruction from the courts, the county boards should file legislative candidates when filing opens tomorrow (Tuesday) morning. The State Board will likewise file congressional candidates.

The following order was entered:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, upon a vote of the majority of judges of the Court, that the Court will rehear the above-captioned cause en banc. The panel's order dated 6 December 2021 issuing a temporary stay is vacated and the Plaintiffs' motion for temporary stay is denied. The en banc Court shall promptly rule on the pending Petition for Writ of Supersedeas or Prohibition.
