The following business was transacted:

Ordered: That the Tax Collector be allowed to employ an office duty at \$2.00 per day until first Monday in March, 1932.

Whereas, it appears at the present time it appears that Columbus County schools will be unable to operate for the extended term of two months on account of lack of sufficient funds; and

Whereas, this Board is desirous of the schools being continued the full eight months, and

Whereas, it appears possible to continue the schools through the extra two months by permitting the tax collector to accept from taxpayers their special school taxes.

Now, therefore, Be it Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners that D. L. Gore, Tax Collector, be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to accept payment of special school taxes, credit the same upon taxpayers original tax receipt, and deliver his personal receipt to said taxpayer for the special school tax so paid.

Be it further resolved that the said Tax Collector may appoint a deputy to assist him for the necessary period of such collections, the deputy to receive the sum of \$2.00 per day.

Be it further resolved that a copy of this resolution be recorded on the minutes of this Board, and a copy sent to the two county newspapers.

The meeting was adjourned until Monday, February 27, 1932.
