Minutes of the last meetings being read and approved the following business was transacted:

Ordered: That S. V. Griffin be refunded taxes for 1930 on \$1200.00 valuation on account of being listed by Jesse F. Williamson.

Ordered: That Lee Carter be allowed ^{refund on} \$500.00 valuation on 1930 taxes.
