Ordered: that \$9,000.00 Columbus County Bonds now the property of said County, being paid in by certain mortgagors indebted to the County and said mortgagors being known as "The Bank of Columbus Bondsmen", said bonds now being in the hands of the County Auditor, A. W. Baldwin. be delivered to the Waccamaw Bank and Trust Co., Whiteville, N. C., as additional security to note or notes of said County, as per agreement with said Bank as recorded in Book # 10 pages 8 and 9.

It is further ordered that an additional \$6,000.00 Columbus County Funding Bonds be transferred from North Carolina Bank and Trust Company where said amount is held for safe keeping to Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company, the said transfer to be made at an early date agreeable with the Chairman and Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners.

Ordered: that Six Thousand (\$6,000.00) Dollars Columbus County Funding Bonds dated January 1, 1928 Nos. 172-173-174-175-191 and 192 be taken from North Carolina Bank and Trust Company, Wilmington, N. C., where the same are being held for safe keeping for Columbus County and be placed with Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company, Whiteville, N. C., and the Chairman and County Accountant of Columbus County are hereby authorized and directed to surrender and properly endorse receipt held by said County and issued by North Carolina Bank and Trust Co., under date of April 11, 1933. Said receipt so dated also describes three other Columbus County Funding Bonds one thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars each which are to be transferred to Wilmington Savings and Trust Company, Wilmington N. C., as per resolution passed by the Board of Commissioners this date.

Ordered: that the Chairman and Clerk of The Board of County Commissioners be authorized and directed to transfer from the North Carolina Bank and Trust Company any and all securities of every kind and nature, including bonds of

Columbus County held by the said Bank for safe keeping, to the Wilmington Savings and Trust Company, Wilmington, N. C., and the said securities are to be held by said Wilmington Savings and Trust Company for safe keeping, and are to be delivered only to the Chairman and Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners upon written receipt of an order directing said Chairman and Clerk to have said securities delivered to them.

Ordered: that Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company, designated depository of the County of Columbus, be required to immediately deliver to Wilmington Savings and Trust Co, Wilmington, N. C., State, Federal, or County bonds, or notes of Columbus County payable to Bearer at said Waccamaw Bank and Trust Co, in the sum of \$60000.00 as security to the deposit or deposits of Columbus County in said Waccamaw Bank and Trust Co, The Said bonds are to be held by said Wilmington Savings and Trust Co., as such depository bond, and shall not be delivered to any person or persons, except upon receipt of a certified copy of a resolution duly adopted by this Board and signed by the Chairman and Clerk, ordering the delivery to said Chairman and Clerk, either in person or by mail.

Ordered: that the Chairman and Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners be directed to obtain and deliver receipt for \$60000.00 Columbus County notes now held by North Carolina Bank and Trust Co., the said notes to be delivered in person to said Chairman and Clerk to Board, the said \$60000.00 having been previously placed with North Carolina Bank and Trust Company by Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company as a depository bond, or for a guarantee of any deposits said County might have in said Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company.
