Be it hereby resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County, North Carolina, in regular meeting assembled, that said County, acting by and through its Board of County Commissioners, shall execute an agreement with the Atlantic Coast Line Railroad Company, covering the lease from said Company, for highway or street purposes, of all that strip or parcel of land lying and being in or near the town of Tabor, North Carolina, with a maximum width of fifteen feet extending ^{southwardly 1850 feet} along the easterly portion of the Railroad Company's right of way from the south corporate limits of said town, all as particularly described in the said agreement dated the 15th day of September, 1933, and as shown on the blue print attached thereto.

It is further resolved that all the terms and conditions, limitations and restrictions set out and contained in said agreement are hereby approved.

Further resolved that said agreement be executed in duplicate as therein stated, in the name and on behalf of and be attested under the corporate seal of said county.

Furhter resolved that this resolution be entered of record on the minutes of this Body.
