Minutes of the last meeting being read and approved the following business was transacted.

Ordered: That the Tax Collector be instructed to separate H. L. Duncan's 1932 Poll and Personal tax so J. J. Formy Duval can pay real estate tax.

Ordered: That Ellis Hawes be admitted to County Home.

Ordered: That Board of Health vouchers be countersigned.

Ordered: That Ed Schwartz's salary be increased to \$50.00 per month beginning January 1st, 1934.

Ordered: That Chairman and Clerk be authorized to sign note for \$2,000.00 due June 30, 1934, for School Sanitation repairs. Said note to be purchased by J. C. Hooks Sr., interest at 6% per annum.

Ordered: That the following resolution be recorded, relative to borrowing Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars for General School purposes.

Be it ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that one note of the County of Columbus for General School purposes be executed in the sum of Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars dated January 10, 1934, maturing July 10, 1934.

The above said note bearing interest at the rate of (6%) six per cent per annum, interest payable at maturity; both principal and interest of said note, payable to BEARER at Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company of the city of Whiteville, N. C., in anticipation of 1933 taxes, and that said note be sold or hypothecated and the proceeds thereof turned into the General Fund of said County of Columbus.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:, That the full faith and credit of the County of Columbus be pledged to the punctual payment of the principal and interest of said note at maturity.

Ordered: That S. L. Smith be allowed to pay \$50.00 in full settlement of J. E. Nobles 1923 taxes in Chadbourn Township.


Ordered: That D.C. High be refunded \$11.00 on 1933 taxes, Welches Creek township, on account of error in listing valuation.
