The following business was transacted.

Ordered: That James Worthington be appointed Registrar of Vital Statistics of Whiteville township in place of E. L. Baldwin, this exchange in appointment is being made by request of Bureau of Vital Statistics, Raleigh, N.C.

Ordered: That J. M. Byrd be refunded tax on amount penalized for 1933 as tax list was lost.

Ordered: That \$60,000.00 Notes due January 29, 1934 be renewed and \$5,000.00 be paid which will be due January 29, 1934.

Ordered: That Pick Strickland's note for \$20.00 be accepted as rent of four acres on J. C. & J. R. Williamson land.

Ordered: That Jim Suggs be dismissed from County Home.

Ordered: That the following resolution be recorded, relative to borrowing Sixty Thousand (\$60,000.00) Dollars for General School purposes, same being renewal notes.

Be it ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that five notes of the County of Columbus for General School purposes be executed, one in the sum of Twenty Five Thousand (\$25,000.00) Dollars, one in the sum of Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000.00) Dollars, one in the sum of Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars, and two in the sum of Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars, dated January 29, 1934, maturing April 28, 1934.

All of the above said notes bearing interest at the rate of (6%) six per-cent per annum, interest payable at maturity; both principal and interest of said notes, payable to BEARER at Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company of the city of Whiteville, N. C., in anticipation of 1933 taxes, and that said notes be sold or hypothecated and the proceeds thereof turned into the General Funds of the <sup>said</sup> County of Columbus.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the full faith and credit of the County of Columbus be pledged to the punctual payment of the principal and interest of said notes at maturity.
