Minutes of the last meeting being read and approved, the following business was transacted.

Ordered: that Archie Hammond be allowed \$2.00 present relief and his name be cut off the Out Door Poor list as he is leaving County.

Ordered: that John F. Heinzl of Delco N. C. be granted license to sell beverage at his place of business as per application filed.

Ordered: that the Board of Health vouchers be countersigned.

Ordered: that Mrs. Maggie Bell Ward be allowed \$15.00 present relief to pay on hospital bill, voucher issued now.

Ordered: that James Ward be allowed \$15.00 present relief to pay on hospital bill, voucher issued now.

Ordered: that W. C. Black of Whiteville N. C. be granted license to sell beverage at his place of business as per application filed.

RESOLUTION

Whereas, it has been represented to this Board that the Whiteville School Building is in need of repairs and additions; that there is a need of new school buildings in Williams Twonship, and at New Hope; that the old school building at Fair Bluff needs to be renovated; that the old school building at Tabor needs a heating plant: Now, therefore,

Be it Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners in regular session:

That the repairs and necessary needs to the Whiteville school building, the construction of new school buildings in Williams Township and at New Hope, the repairs and renovations to the old school building at Fair Bluff, the installation of a heating plant in the old school building at Tabor, be made as soon as the controversy and difference between this Board and the Board of Education can be adjusted, and when the necessary funds can be raised.

It is further ordered that a copy of this be turned over to the Press for publication.

RESOLUTION

Whereas, certain citizens of Waccamaw Township have requested the Board of County Commissioners to recommend the taking over and maintaining of a certain road in said township by the State Highway Commission; and,

Whereas, it appears that the said road which it is desired by said citizens that the State Highway Commission take over and maintain is a road beginning at Mr. I. B. Sloan's store foing North of Lake Waccamaw and it is about six and one-fourth miles entering into the North East road opposite Ben R. Spaulding's farm; and,

Whereas, this road, if maintained, will be about five or six miles nearer for Bladen County citizens leaving Highway # 211 coming to Lake Waccamaw; and,

Whereas, this road is already partly shrubbed and ditched:

Now therefore, Be It Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners that the State Highway Commission be and it is hereby requested to take over and maintain this certain road: and,

Be it further resolved that a copy of this resolution be sent to the State Highway Commission in Raleigh and a copy be recorded on the Minutes of this Board.
