Whereas, this road is a distance of one mile beginning at St. Marks Church on the old Wilmington Road and intersects the road leading from J. W. Brinkley Store at Highway # 20 to J. C. Nye Place; and,

Whereas, this road has been ditched and partly constructed and if taken over by the State Highway Commission, will save citizens living near said road nine miles going to Bolton:

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that the State Highway Commission be and it is hereby requested to take over and maintain this certain road; and,

Be it further resolved that a copy of this resolution be sent to the State Highway Commission in Raleigh and a copy be recorded on the Minutes of this Board.

Whereas, certain citizens of Lees Township have requested the Board of County Commissioners to recommend the construction of a causeway at the Stanley Ford, Beaver Dam Swamp, which is about half-way between the Etta Ford and Nellie Ford; and,

Whereas, this said causeway would connect Camp Bay Road with the Mollie-Clarendon Road making the nearest direct route from Hallsboro to Tabor; and,

Whereas, a causeway at this Ford, it is believed, will accomodate more peple and can be built with less expense to the State than any other Ford that will be petitioned for:
