

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office June 18th, 1934, according to adjournment. Members of the Board present:

The following business was transacted.

Ordered: that Mrs. S. J. Spivey, Administratrix, be refunded tax on \$1,000.00 valuation for years 1930 and 1931 on account of error in listing number of acres.

Ordered: that Mrs. D. J. Prince be refunded tax on \$700 valuation for the years 1932 and 1933 and that the valuation for 1934 be placed at \$2,000.00.

Ordered: that \$66.00 be paid Baker Sanatorium for hospital expense of Oliver Shipman.

Ordered: that \$10.00 be paid Baker Sanatorium for hospital expense of Odell Watts.

Ordered: that State Highway Commission be requested to let contract soon as possible for hard surfacing of Route # 130 to the Brunswick County line.

Ordered: that Charles Drissel Jr. be granted license to sell Beverages as per application filed June 11th, 1934.

Ordered: that O. C. Coleman 16 acres of land in Ransom Township be valued at \$300.00, said 16 acres listed with S. Mitchell taxes.

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Ordered: that W. L. Hobbs be authorized and instructed to accompany A. W. Baldwin, Clerk to Board, in place of C. D. Garrell, Chairman, to get Bonds and Coupons now due or will be due July 1st, 1934, stored with Wilmington Savings and Trust Company and Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company for safe keeping for Columbus County.

Ordered: that Jesse F. Williamson automobile for 1934 tax valuation be assessed at \$125. on account of his automobile being burned.

Ordered: that the following resolution be recorded relative to borrowing Twelve Thousand (\$12,000.00) Dollars for the purpose of paying interest on Road and Bridge Bonds.

Be it ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that one note of the County of Columbus for the purpose of paying interest on Road and Bridge Bonds, be executed in the sum of Twelve Thousand (\$12,000.00) Dollars, dated July 1st, 1934, and maturing August 29th, 1934.

The above note bearing interest at the rate of (6%) six per-cent per annum, interest payable at maturity; both principal and interest of said note payable to BEARER at Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company of the city of Whiteville, N. C. in anticipation of 1933 taxes, and that said note be sold or hypothecated and the proceeds thereof turned into the General Funds of said County of Columbus.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the full faith and credit of the County of Columbus be pledged to the punctual payment of the principal and interest of said note at maturity.

On August 29th, 1934 the County of Columbus for value received, promises to pay to the BEARER hereof at the Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company in the City of Whiteville, N. C., the sum of Twelve Thousand (\$12,000.00) Dollars with interest at (6%) six per-cent per annum.

This note is issued in accordance with the County Finance Act and in pursuance of a resolution duly adopted by the Board of Commissioners of County of Columbus on the 18th day of June 1934 and duly signed by the Chairman and Clerk of said Board as required by law.

It is hereby certified and recited that each and every act, condition, and thing required to be done, to have happened, and to be performed precedent to and in the issuance of this note, has been done, has happened, and has been performed in full and strict compliance with the Constitution and laws of the State of North Carolina and that this note is within every debt and other limit

prescribed by law, and the faith and credit of the County of Columbus are hereby irrevocable pledged to the punctual payment of the Principal and interest of this note, according to its terms.

In witness whereof, the County of Columbus has caused its Corporate name to be signed hereto by the Chairman of Board of Commissioners and the Corporate seal to be hereunto affixed and attested by the Clerk to the Board of Commissioners, this the 18th day of June, 1934.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time, adjournment was voted in order until Monday July 2nd, 1934.
