Ordered: that Johnson Hospital be allowed and mailed voucher for \$10.00 on hospital bill of Butler Clewis.

Ordered: that Dr. G. D. Elliott be allowed \$10.00 on hospital bill of Arm Hinson.

Ordered: that a tax levy of .01 be included in Cooperative Health Tax rate for 1934, to be used in paying hospital bills.

Ordered: that the Co operative Health Budget total amount for 1934 be fixed at \$3,500.00 of which the County's part will be \$2,975.00 and the State's part \$525.00.

Ordered: that \$55,000.00 Columbus County Notes now in Wilmington Savings and Trust Company made payable to BEARER at Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company and held by Wilmington Savings and Trust Company placed there by Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company as security for deposits in said Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company be released, and in lieu thereof, renewal notes in the sum of \$55,000.00 be placed with said Wilmington Savings and Trust Company in place of the said sum of \$55,000.00 notes. Said renewal notes dated July 26, 1934, due September 24, 1934.

Ordered: that no change be made in tax valuation of Beaufort County Lumber Company in Whiteville Township for year 1934.

Ordered: that Chairman be authorized and instructed to sign contract employing D. E. Perkinson and Company represented by D. N. Blue to make an audit of County Accountant's office, Tax Collector's office, Register of Deeds office, and Sheriff's office from July 1st, 1933 to December 3rd, 1934 and for the Clerk of Superior Court's office from January 1st, 1931 to December 3rd, 1934, at the price of \$1,800.00.

Ordered: that the following resolution be recorded relative to borrowing Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars for General School purposes, same being renewal notes.

Be it ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that one note of the County of Columbus for General School purposes be executed in the sum of Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars same being renewal note, dated July 10, 1934, maturing January 10, 1935.

The above note bearing interest at the rate of (6%) six per cent per annum, interest payable at maturity; both principal and interest of said note payable to BEARER at Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company, of the City of Whiteville N. C., in anticipation of 1934 taxes, and that said note be sold or hypothecated and the proceeds thereof turned into the General Fund of said County of Columbus.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the full faith and credit of the County of Columbus be pledged to the punctual payment of the principal and interest of said note at maturity.
