Minutes fo the last meeting being read and approved, the following business was transacted.

Ordered: that the Tax Collector accept note for \$25.00 from H. M. Bullard due September 15th, 1934 for Schedule B. License.

Ordered: that Mrs. Rosa E. Buffkin be notified that her real estate mortgage to Columbus County will not be cancelled until she pays Jackson Greer \$10.00 for legal service in connection with her foreclosure proceedings which were postponed.

Ordered: that the Co operative Health vouchers be countersigned.

Ordered: that W. M. Carter be allowed to peddle in Columbus County for the year 1934-1935 without paying County license.

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Ordered: that I. C. Jordan of Whiteville N. C. be granted license to sell beverages at his place of business as per application filed.

Ordered: that Mrs. Ethel Little be given \$2.00 present relief voucher to be mailed to her at Cerro Gordo, N. C.

Ordered: that G. G. Carmichael salary be increased \$15.00 per month.

Ordered: that Thomason-Ripple Lumber Company check for \$188.44 made payable to J. C. & J. R. Williamson for timber sold be cashed and \$47.11 be given to said Williamsons as per former agreement which is one-fourth, and County's part to be credited on Williamson's taxes.

Ordered: that all offices except Tax Collector's be allowed to close on Saturdays at one o'clock P. M. until September 1st, 1934, inclusive.

Ordered: that the Tax Collector be authorized and instructed to postpone 1933 tax land sale list, and advertise first week in September and sell first Monday in October 1934.

Ordered: that A. W. Baldwin purchase material for repairing plumbing at Jail and bids will be received August 15th for installing said repairs.

Whereas, certain citizens of Columbus County have requested the Board of County Commissioners to recommend the construction of a road in said County by the State Highway Commission; and,

Whereas, the said road which it is desired by said citizens that the State Highway Commission construct is an old road bed right of way of the logging rail road of Jackson Brothers Lumber Company, beginning at a point known as the John Harrelson Crossing and extending along said right of way and road bed for a distance of approximately seven miles to the junction with another road at a point known as the Poley Bridge Crossing; and,

Whereas, the rail on said rail road bed has been removed and the road, if constructed, will prove very beneficial to the surrounding

community:

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that the State Highway Commission be and it is hereby requested that said road be constructed; and,

Be it further resolved that a copy of this resolution be sent to the State Highway Commission in Raleigh and a copy be recorded on the Minutes of this Board.
