Minutes of the last meeting being read and approved, the following business was transacted.

Ordered: that Ruth White be admitted to County Home.

Ordered: that Zeb Butler be allowed \$1.00 present relief and \$1.00 per month.

Ordered: that Oscar Soles valuation on 8 acres in South Williams township be reduced from \$225.00 to \$125.00 and a release be given on taxes for 1930-1931-1932-1933, and 1934 for \$100.00 for each year.

Ordered: that S. V. Griffin be released on 50 acres \$400.00 valuation listed by Jesse Williamson, for 1930.

Ordered: that Nashfield Moore be released of tax on \$400.00 valuation on McLean and Croom tract of land in Welches Creek Township, for 1930.

Ordered: that S. Mitchell Estate taxes in Ransom Township be separated so E. N. Zeigler may pay taxes on 225 acres and 40 acres for years 1928 to 1934 inclusive. It is further ordered that said two tracts be valued at \$2,000.00 for years 1932-1933-1934, inclusive.

Ordered: that Maybelle Lee be allowed to pay taxes for 1930-1931-1932-1933 without paying penalty.

Ordered: that Chairman cancell note and mortgage of G. O. Boyette to Columbus County.

Ordered: that on motion of R. C. Benton, seconded by L. E. Formy-Duval, that no appropriation be made for 1934-1935 for forest fire protection in Columbus County.

Ordered: that 18 acre tract of land listed by D. N. Hathway for 1930-1931-1932-1933, and 1934 be cancelled and D. M. Stanley be charged with taxes for 1930-1931-1932-1933, and 1934 on 18 acres valued at \$180.00 per year, and D. N. Hathway be cut off list for 1934, and all other years.

Ordered: that no appropriation be made for purchase of school trucks and bodies for 1934-1935 term of school for Columbus County.

Ordered: That town lot listed in name of Jim Ellis known as Roy Gore lot be valued at \$200.00 for 1931-1932-1933, and 1934, and a refund be issued for said difference in taxes charged.

Ordered: that Planters Tobacco House Company's valuation be reduced \$3,500.00 on account of house being burned.
