Ordered: that typewriter be purchased for County Farm Agent's office.

Ordered: that refund be issued to Acme Mfg. Co. for \$101,948 Val. on Personal Property for 1934 on account of increasing valuation in stock of merchandise.

Ordered: that Acme Mfg. Co. be allowed to pay their 1934 taxes with a discount of 2 per-cent instead of 1 1/2 per-cent as allowed for September on account of Company's valuation being increased by error.

Ordered: that Conister Chemical Company be allowed to pay their 1932 excess tax without paying penalty.

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Ordered: that W. G. Prevatte be allowed a refund for \$8.80 on account of error in listing solvent credits.

Ordered: that no appropriation be made for purchasing school trucks and busses in Columbus County for school year 1934-1935.

Ordered: that all taxes collected by Tax Collector of Columbus County be deposited in Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company, County Depository, as Columbus County Tax Collector Fund and that funds so deposited by the said Tax Collector be and are hereby considered as county funds and be covered by county bond with said Depository. It is further ordered that funds deposited to this said account are not subject to withdrawal by the said Tax Collector for any purpose. It is also ordered that all duplicate tax receipts be turned over daily to Columbus County Auditor.

Ordered: that the following resolution be recorded relative to borrowing Fifty Five Thousand (\$55,000.00) Dollars for General School purposes, same being renewal notes.

Be it ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that four notes of the County of Columbus for General School purposes be executed, one in the sum of Twenty Five Thousand (\$25,000.00) Dollars, one in the sum of Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000.00) Dollars, one in the sum of Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars, and one in the sum of Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars, dated September 24th 1934, maturing December 23rd 1934.

All of the above notes bearing interest at the rate of six (6%) per-cent per annum from date, interest payable at maturity; both principal and interest of said notes payable to BEARER at the Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company of the City of Whiteville N. C., in anticipation of 1934 taxes, and that said notes be sold or hypothecated and the proceeds thereof turned into the General Funds of said County of Columbus.
