Minutes of the last meeting being read and approved, the following business was transacted.

Ordered: that Mrs. S. D. Register be allowed \$3.00 present relief.

Ordered: that E. T. McKeithan be allowed to pay 1932 and prior taxes by paying 6% and court cost.

Ordered: that the Tax Collector issue license to slot machine owners when such operator presents his State license, the amount of said license to be in conformity with the amount charged by the State of North Carolina.

Ordered: that J. M. Leigh be granted peddlers' license in Columbus County for products manufactured in his own name, it appearing that he is a disabled war veteran.

Ordered: that inmates at County Home be required to stay at County Home at all times unless permission be given by Superintendent to be away.

Ordered: that Co operative Health work vouchers be countersigned.

On motion of F. M. Stanley, seconded by H. G. Avant, it is ordered that \$1,500.00 be appropriated for Farm Demonstration work in Columbus County for year 1935-1936, all Commissioners voting therefor except R. C. Benton.

Ordered: that D. L. & M. F. Harrelson be allowed to pay 1932 and prior years taxes by paying 6% and court cost.

Ordered: that Chairman be authorized to sign agreement for the protection from fire of forest lands in Columbus County, North Carolina, and forward it to the Department of Conservation and Development, Raleigh, N. C.

Ordered: that the 1935-1936 budget for County Board of Education be approved for the following amounts:

Ordered: That the following resolution be recorded relative to borrowing Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars for General School Purposes, same being renewal note.

Be it ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that one note of the County of Columbus for General School purposes be executed in the sum of Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars, dated July 10th, 1935, maturing January 10th, 1936.

The above said note bearing interest at the rate of six (6%) per-cent per annum, interest payable at maturity; both principal and interest of said note payable to BEARER at the Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company, of the City of Whiteville, N. C., in anticipation of 1935 taxes, and that said note be sold or hypothecated and the proceeds thereof turned into the General Fund of said County of Columbus.
