RESOLUTION

Whereas, the Board of Commissioners of Columbus County has filed the application which is now pending with the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works for a grant and loan for the purpose of constructing a County Home; and,

Whereas, the Board of Commissioners of Columbus County is now informed that allotments for funds will first be considered by the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works for projects for which applications for grants only are pending; and,

Whereas, it is the opinion of this Board that Columbus County can finance fifty-five per cent of the cost of this project at an interest rate of less than four per cent, this being the amount offered by the Government, from sources other than the Public Works Administration:

Now, therefore, Be It Resolved by the Board of Commissioners of Columbus County that the application heretofore made for this project and now pending with the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works be, and it is hereby authorized and instructed to change the application of said project from that of "loan and grant", to that of "grant only".

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time, adjournment was voted in order until Monday July 6th, 1936.
