ORDERED. That the following resolution be recorded relative to borrowing Ten

Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars for General School purposes.

Be it ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County,
that one note of the County of Columbus be executed, in the sum of Ten Thousand
(\$10,000.00) Dollars for General School purposes, said note to be dated March
30th, 1938, maturing June 30th, 1938.

The above said note bearing interest at the rate of five (5%) per-cent
per annum, interest payable at maturity; both principal and interest of said ~~note~~
note payable to BEARER at the Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company, of the City of
Whiteville, N. C., in anticipation of 1937 taxes, said note to be sold or hypo-
thecated and the proceeds thereof turned into the General Fund for General ~~School~~
School purposes.

Be it further resolved that the full faith and credit of the County of
Columbus be pledged to the punctual payment of the principal and interest of
said note at maturity.
