

## RESOLUTION

Whereas, certain citizens of Cerro Gordo Township have petitioned the Honorable Board of County Commissioners to recommend the taking over and maintaining of a certain road in said township by the State Highway and Public Works Commission; and,

Whereas, said road which it is desired by said citizens that the State Highway and Public Works Commission take over and maintain is the road leading from the Highway that runs from Cerro Gordo to Odum Williamson's filling station, being seven tenths of a mile; and,

Whereas, several families live on said road and school children are forced to walk out to the above mentioned highway to meet the school bus; and,

Whereas, said road is badly in need of repair:

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Board of Commissioners of Columbus County that the State Highway and Public Works Commission be and it is hereby requested to take over and maintain said road; and,

Be it further resolved that a copy of this resolution be sent to the State Highway and Public Works Commission in Raleigh and a copy be recorded on the Minutes of this Board.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time, adjournment was voted in order until December 12th, 1938.

Upon motion of H. G. Avant, seconded by W. M. Stephens, the following resolution was passed by the Board of Commissioners of Columbus County:

Be it resolved that the County of Columbus issue its note in the amount of \$55,000.00 for the purpose of providing its share of the expense of construction of

a County Hospital:

Be it further resolved that said note shall mature six months from date of issuance and bear an interest rate of not more than six percent. Said note to be Revenue Bond Anticipation Note.

Upon motion of H. G. Avant, seconded by W. M. Stephens, the following resolution was passed by the Board of Commissioners of Columbus County:

BE IT RESOLVED that the County of Columbus issue its note in the amount of \$12,000.00 for the purpose of paying principal and interest on bonds due January 1st, 1939:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said note shall mature three months from date of issuance and bear an interest rate of not more than six percent. Said note to be Revenue Anticipation Note.

Ordered: that W. E. Harrelson, Tax Collector, be authorized and instructed to proceed with levy on Personal property on January 1st, 1939 on all delinquent taxes due Columbus County as provided by law.

Ordered: that all County Officers be allowed to close their offices on Friday P. M. December 23rd until Tuesday A. M. December 27th for Christmas holidays.

Ordered: that R. B. Edmund be allowed to pay his 1934 and prior years taxes at par if paid by January 1st, 1939.

Ordered: that A. L. Horne be allowed to pay his 1935 and 1936 taxes in Bolton Township at same valuation as 1937.
