The following business was transacted.

WHEREAS, it has been called to the attention of the Board by the Local Government Commission that Columbus County owns \$122,500.00 of its own bonds which were bought in by the County; and,

WHEREAS, the County now has \$74,000.00 of its notes, same being outstanding, drawing 6% interest, and have been renewed several times, and also have \$50,000.00 Road and Bridge Bonds becoming due and payable on May 1st, 1941:

NOW, THEREFORE, it has been recommended by C. M. Johnson, State Treasurer and by W. E. Easterling, Secretary of the Local Government Commission, through J. K. Powell, County Attorney and A. W. Baldwin, County Auditor, and also by a letter from C. A. Adams, that this Board sell its \$122,500.00 in bonds owned and pay the \$74,000.00 in notes and the remaining \$48,500.00 be held to pay on the \$50,000.00 Road and Bridge Bonds due May 1st, 1941.

This Board requested the Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company to secure bids for the sale of above mentioned bonds and after due consideration of bids submitted, this Board accepts the offer of \$132,539.52, and C. A. Small, Chairman, and A. W. Baldwin, Clerk, are authorized to deliver said bonds at above price mentioned, to the Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company.

The above resolution was offered by R. C. Benton and seconded by W. L. Hobbs, and all Commissioners present voting therefor.

Ordered: that taxes due Town of Chadbourn on Hughes property be paid.

Ordered: that the Tax Collector issue license to H. D. Carney to retail beverages as provided by the "1933 Beverage Control Act" as amended.

On motion of W. L. Hobbs, seconded by R. C. Benton, it is ordered that K. Clyde Council be re-appointed member of County Welfare Board for a term of three years.

Resolution

Ordered: that the following resolution be recorded relative to borrowing Twenty Five Thousand (\$25,000.00) Dollars for General County purposes.

Be it ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that one note of the County of Columbus for General County purposes be executed in the sum of Twenty Five Thousand (\$25,000.00) Dollars, dated April 20th, 1939, maturing July 30th, 1939.

The above note bearing interest at the rate of one and one half ( $1\frac{1}{2}\%$ ) percent per annum, interest payable at maturity; both principal and interest of said note payable to BEARER at the Wachovia Bank and Trust Company of Winston Salem, N. C., in anticipation of 1938 taxes, and that said note be sold or hypothecated and the proceeds thereof turned into the General Fund of said County of Columbus.

Be it further resolved that the full faith and credit of the County of Columbus be pledged to the punctual payment of the principal and interest of said note at maturity.
