

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office May 29th, 1939, according to adjournment. Members of the Board present:

The following business was transacted.

On motion of W. L. Hobbs, seconded by R. C. Benton, it is ordered that the \$48,000.00 received from sale of bonds be placed in Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company they to issue Certificate of Deposit to draw interest at 2 % until May 1st, 1941, at which time a Road and Bridge Bond issue will be due and the \$2,000.00 which was due May 1st, 1939 by Board of Education, also be placed with said Bank and receive a Certificate of Deposit to draw interest when the said Board of Education issues voucher to pay said amount. The remaining \$500.00 received from sale of bonds to be put in the Bond Interest and Redemption Fund.

Ordered: that the following be appointed as ~~Trustees~~ Building Committees for County Hospital: K. Clyde Council, C. L. Tate, A. F. Powell, I. B. Tucker Sr, ~~and~~ C. A. Small, and R. M. Garrell.

Ordered: that J. A. Boone be allowed to pay 1938 and prior years taxes due at par and \$3.00 court cost each for three suits, on a valuation of \$3,000.00 for Bogue Township and \$1,000.00 for Welches Creek Township.

Ordered: that Lizzie Summersett's application to retail beverages under the "1933 Beverage Control Act" be refused.

On motion of W. L. Hobbs, seconded by H. G. Avant, it is ordered that Julian D. Lewis be given until May 1st, 1940 to close up land sales certificates he has for foreclosing.

Ordered: that the Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company be allowed to pledge to the County as a bond to secure deposits of Columbus County in said bank as depository in place of a \$52,000.00 Columbus County note the following \$50,000.00 in Certificate of Deposits of other banks, amount of Certificate not to amount to more than \$5,000.00 for any one bank. Said securities to be placed in safety lock box in Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company.

Ordered: that Chairman and Clerk sign vouchers when proceeds of bonds issue are received, for Columbus County Hospital, to the following: \$2,922.37 to U. A. Underwood and Co., \$8,500.00 to Dr. W. E. Miller, and \$3,416.00 to Leslie N. Boney.

ORDERED: that one \$52,000.00 Columbus County Note dated January 10, 1939, maturing July 10, 1939, now in Security National Bank, made payable to BEARER at the Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company and held by Security National Bank and placed there by Waccamaw Bank and Trust Co. as security for deposits in said Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company be released as same has been paid.
