Minutes of the last meeting being read and approved the following business was transacted.

Ordered: that W. L. Hobbs be named acting Chairman in place of C. A. Small, who is absent.

Ordered: that Mrs. Susie Thompson be allowed to pay \$5.00 per month on her past due taxes.

Ordered: that B. B. Blake be given until May 1st, 1940 to pay balance due on his mortgage and interest.

Ordered: that Ollie Barefoot be allowed a refund for 1938 and 1939 Poll tax and issue an exemption order from paying Poll tax during his disability.

Ordered: that J. O. Williamson be allowed to pay \$20.00 on his mortgage December 1st, 1939 and \$20.00 the first of each month until paid in full.

Ordered that V. S. and Cora B. Smith's valuation for 1939 & prior years due on 1 town lot in Whiteville township be reduced from \$360.00 to \$200.00.

ROAD RESOLUTION
