The following business was transacted.

Ordered: that the Co operative Extension Work in Agriculture and Economics budget be fixed at \$2,680.00 for 1940-1941.

Ordered: that the 1940-1941 School budget be fixed at 40¢.

On motion of R. C. Benton, seconded by H. G. Avant, it is ordered that the order passed June 3rd, 1940 relative to taking care of Bladen County inmates be rescinded.

On motion of C. A. Small, seconded by H. G. Avant, it is ordered that for 1940-1941, the County pay to Columbus County Hospital, \$2.00 per day for charity patients.

Ordered: that Dr. Floyd Johnson, County Health Officer, be authorized to examine and pass upon charity patients before entering hospital for treatment. If for any reason Dr. Johnson is not available, the Superintendent at hospital shall pass upon said patients.

On motion of C. A. Small, seconded by G. C. Hinson, it is ordered that Mrs. Lollie Mae Cobb and Miss Mamie Brown be paid \$100.00 per month each and that A. W. Baldwin be paid \$200.00 per month, all beginning July 1st, 1940.

Ordered: that the Chairman sign application for Ralph Jeffries, colored, to be admitted to deaf school.

Ordered: that awnings or blinds be put on West windows of the Tax Collector's office and on the West windows of the Welfare Office.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time, adjournment was voted until June 28th, 1940.
 Ordered: that the D. J. Hughes Co. valuation in South Williams Township be reduced on manufacturing property from \$7,000.00 to \$5,000.00.

Ordered: that Bowers and Bennett valuation in Bug Hill Township for 1940 on 631 acres of land be fixed at \$5.00 per acre.

Ordered: that A. W. Baldwin, Clerk to Board, file application with the Local Government Commission of Raleigh, N. C. for the approval to issue a note in the sum of \$17,000.00 to become due three (3) months from date to pay \$12,640.78 Bonds and Interest due July 1st, 1940, \$2,915.74 to pay State of N. C. for school busses and \$1,443.48 for school furniture purchased under State contract.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time, adjournment was voted until June 28th, 1940.
