



The following business was transacted.

Ordered: that the property owned by The Confederate Woman's Home, known as the Mrs. H. C. Moffitt tract, Whiteville, N. C., Whiteville Township, be exempted from taxes for 1941 and prior years.

Ordered: that refund be issued to Delinquent Tax Collector for Zeb Bullard, Tatum Township, for \$2.00 dog tax for year 1932 and for \$1.00 dog tax for year 1931.

Ordered: that tax notes and tax deeds owned by Columbus County be included in the contract of Mrs. Grace G. Baldwin, Delinquent Tax Collector, with instructions that she proceed to collect same in accordance with the agreement relative to the collections of delinquent land sales certificates.

Ordered: that employees operating in the court house be granted Saturday morning, July 5th, 1941 as a holiday with pay.

Ordered: that B. L. Martin, Tax Collector, be required to deposit his tax collections daily with Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company, County Depository, as County Undistributed Funds to be disbursed only upon check signed by County Auditor and countersigned by Tax Collector. It is further ordered that he be required to make distributions twice monthly to the various funds.

Ordered: that one (1) acre of the Lucian (J. L.) Smith property known as the old agricultural site, in Williams Township, be segregated for the year 1940 so that George Leamon Ikner can pay 1940 taxes due on a valuation of \$40.00 on same.

Ordered: that L. E. Marsh be allowed to settle the Perry E. Davis Estate, Whiteville Township, for 1936 and prior years taxes due on a \$400.00 valuation plus the 6% and 1/2/court cost.

Ordered: that H. S. Kimery, Clinton, N. C., be allowed to settle 1939 and 1940 years' taxes due on lot known as the Sam Wright property, Waccamaw Township on \$1000 valuation.

Old Age Assistance to be as for the previous year; Aid to Dependent Children to provide for a total of 335 children; and the Social Security Administration to remain as provided for during the previous year, including the services of the extra caseworker, Miss Alice Shelly.

Ordered: that Leslie Pierce tax, Bogue Township, be segregated so that C. P. Holcomb may pay tax on the 120 acres valued at \$1855 and 2/3 of the personal property in settlement of tax on said 120 acres for years 1939 and 1940.

Ordered: that A. D. Nealy, Williams Township, be refunded \$1.00 on 1940 taxes, due to error in listing dog.

Ordered: that the Board meet as a Committee on June 20th for the purpose of revising the 1941 Jury List.
