The above note bearing interest at the rate of two and one-half per cent per annum, interest payable at maturity; both principal/and interest is said note payable to BEARER at FIRST CITIZENS BANK AND TRUST COMPANY, RALEIGH, NORTH CAROLINA, in anticipation of 1941 taxes, and that said note be sold or hypothecated and the proceeds thereof turned into the General Fund of said County of Columbus.

Be it further resolved that the full faith and credit of the County of Columbus be pledged to the punctual payment of the principal and interest of said note at maturity.

This note is issued pursuant to the County Finance Act, as amended, and a resolution duly adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of said County for necessary expenses and for the purpose of paying appropriations made for the current fiscal year and in **thus** anticipation of the collection of taxes and other revenues of such fiscal year,

It is hereby certified and recited that all acts, conditions and things required by the statutes and Constitution of the State of North Carolina to be performed, happen and exist precedent to and in the issuance of this note have been performed, have happened and exist, and that this note is within every debt and other limitation prescribed by said statutes and Constitution. For the prompt payment hereof, both principal and interest as the same fall due, the full faith and credit of said County are hereby irrevocably pledged.
