The following business was transacted.

Ordered: that Forney Baldwin, Welches Creek Township, 14 acre tract, be segregated so that E. D. Moore can pay taxes thereon at its valuation and its pro rata share of personal property providing that taxes for years 1929, 1930, 1931 and 1932 be paid at par plus 6% and 1/2 court cost.

Ordered: that James Perkins, Whiteville Township, 2 acres, be segregated so that Lena Smith can pay taxes thereon at its valuation and its pro rata share of personal taxes thereon.

Ordered: that surveyor be engaged to run out land sold to C. E. Stephens by tax deed, cost not to exceed \$10.00.
