This note is issued pursuant to the County Finance Act, as amended, and a resolution duly adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of said county for necessary expenses and for the purpose of paying the principal or interest of bonds or notes due or to become due within four months and not otherwise adequately provided for, and in anticipation of the receipt of taxes and other revenue of the current fiscal year.

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED AND RECITED that all acts, conditions and things required by the Statutes and Constitution of the State of North Carolina to be performed, happen and exist precedent to and in the issuance of this note have been performed, have happened and exist, and that this note is within every debt and other limitation prescribed by said Statutes and Constitution. For the prompt payment here-

of, both principal and interest as the same fall due, the full faith and credit of said County are hereby irrevocably pledged.

Ordered: that 28 acre tract listed in 1941 by Obed Pridgen, Tatum Township and valued at \$1,235.00 be separated from a 25 acre tract valued at \$1,080 and a \$100 personal valuation be segregated from his \$163 valuation so that the Federal Land Bank can pay¹⁹⁴¹ taxes on \$1,335 valuation.
