The following business was transacted.

Ordered: that Miss Genevieve Eakes be employed as County Home Demonstration Agent for Columbus County for the ensuing year beginning July 1, 1943.

Ordered: that P. D. Johnson, Ransom Township, be refunded on \$400 valuation and \$2.00 Poll tax for year 1942 due to his house being burned.

Ordered: that the 1941 and 1942 tax of Ruther Lee Soles, South Williams Township, be cancelled as Columbus County owned the property during those years and has now sold same to Morgan Soles for enough to take care of said taxes.

Ordered: that 1937 and 1938 tax on personal property of I. M. Bullard, Chadhourn Township, be cancelled as the present owners of the lands listed by him for those years have been heretofore allowed to pay on the real estate now owned by them, and I M. Bullard is now a non-resident of Columbus County.

Ordered: that 1942 personal property tax of James V. Williams, Ransom Township, be cancelled as he was a resident of New Hanover County; and, that James V. Williams be allowed to pay on his land according to the valuation thereof.

Ordered: that 1938 tax of Dorcas Ann Ward, Williams Township, be segregated so that Edmond Ward can pay tax on 20 acres of David Ward land valued \$100.00.

Ordered: that Robert Powell, colored, be issued a refund in the amount of \$2.16 as the taxes of Robert E. Powell, white, in Bogue Township for the year 1941 were garnisheed and collected by the Tax Collector from Robert Powell, colored, in addition to his own taxes for the same year.

ORDINANCE REGULATING THE CLOSING HOURS OF
PLACES SELLING BEER ON COLUMBUS COUNTY

The Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County do order:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation, licensed to sell beer in Columbus County to sell, or offer for sale, any beer in Columbus County between the hours of eleven-thirty P.M. each Saturday and seven A.M. each Monday.

Section 2. That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation, licensed to sell beer in Columbus County, to permit or allow the consumption of any beer in any place in Columbus County under the control of, or being operated by, said licensee, between the hours of twelve midnight Saturday and seven A.M. each Monday.

Section 3. That any person, firm, or corporation, licensed to sell beer violating the provisions of this Ordinance, or any person, firm, or corporation, licensed to sell beer, violating any regulations which may be made under this Ordinance by the County Commissioners of the county in which said person, firm, or corporation is licensed to sell beer, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon
