The following business was transacted.

Ordered: that H. T. Dillon be granted an extension until April 30th, 1944 to pay the taxes due of Mrs. Claudia M. Weisenbaum, Eureka Farms and Virgil W. Schumacher as provided in order passed by the Board under date of November 2, 1942, provided the taxes due presented in said order of all other taxes on said list are paid by January 3, 1944.

Ordered: that Mrs. Homer Nance, Boardman, N. C. Rt. 1, be appointed Registrar of Vital Statistics for Tatum Township.

Ordered: that W. P. Suggs' 1937 tax in Bug Hill Township be allowed paid at par plus 6% upon the payment of full amount of all other taxes due.

Ordered: that the balance of J. D. Young tax in Bogue Township for the year 1939 be cancelled and the tax collector granted a refund therefor, as the balance is the tax levied on the H. W. Young property owned by the County. It is further ordered that a quit-claim deed be given to J. D. Young for the H. W. Young property in Bogue Township as recorded in Book 157, page 538.

Ordered: that the J. T. Ward Estate tax in Lees Township for years 1930 to 1935 inclusive be segregated so that Mrs. Mary Mercer can pay on the 7 acres of this land that she owns at a valuation of \$150.00.

Ordered: that the valuation of property of Len Tyler in South Williams Township for the years 1941, 1942 and 1943 be reduced from \$1250 to \$900, and that this change be made in the Tax Supervisor's office, and that upon the payment by Len Tyler of his taxes for said years that the tax collector be granted a refund covering the tax on the amount by which his taxes are reduced.
