

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office Monday, March 6th, 1944, it being first Monday. Members of the Board present:

The following business was transacted.

Ordered: that H. T. Dillon be allowed to settle taxes due for John Schultz, Bolton Township, for years ~~1939~~, 1940 and 1941 in the amount of \$36.11; W. R. Simpson taxes due in Bolton Township for \$83.03 as follows: 1939 tax at \$26.85, 1940 tax at \$26.92 and 1941 tax at \$29.26; and Charles M. Brown taxes due in Bolton Township for years 1933, 1934, 1935, 1936, 1937, 1938, 1939, 1940 and 1941 in the amount of \$249.38 and that the tax collector be refunded the differences in said years taxes due, Be it further ordered that \$9.00 be accepted in full settlement of court cost on said taxes.

Ordered: that W. H. Parker be allowed to settle 1938 and prior years taxes due of J. H. Rheder Heirs, Bolton Township, at par plus 6% and 1/2 court cost; and it is further ordered that a partial payment made on 8-23-38 in the amount of \$10.85 be given credit on 1937 taxes due as same was not credited on said year.

Ordered: that Dorothy Davis, AAA Secretary, be paid \$1.00 per day from General County Fund, effective as of February 1, 1944.

Ordered: that Kyard Brown, Extension Secretary, be paid \$10.00 per month from General County Fund, effective as of February 1, 1944.

Ordered: that Millie Andrews be allowed to pay \$15.00 per month on tax deed.

Ordered: that Rosier Williams, Jailor, be allowed \$.80 per day for care of prisoners, effective as of March 1, 1944.

Ordered: that the Chairman and Clerk be authorized and instructed to sign Bond Interest and Redemption Fund voucher in the amount of \$501.25 to pay interest and exchange due April 1, 1944.

Ordered: that 2-\$500 Columbus County (Tabor Supplemental School District) Bonds Nos. 8 and 9 due 2-16-44 held by Wachovia Bank and Trust Company, Raleigh, N. C., placed there by Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company, Whiteville, N. C., for security of deposits of Columbus County, be released, and in lieu thereof, 1-\$1,000 Columbus County Home Bond #24 due 7-1-50, with 7-1-44 and subsequent coupons attached, be placed with said Wachovia Bank and Trust Company subject to the order of the Board of County Commissioners.

Ordered: that the tax collector be granted a refund in the amount of \$3.00 on T. W. Webb Heirs taxes for year 1941 in Bolton Township as this tax is \$3.00 more than it should be due to an error in addition in preparing the tax sale certificate.

Ordered: that L. Rossie Fowler tax in South Williams Township for the year 1943 be segregated so that James Roberts can pay on 2 3/10 acres thereof with a valuation of \$400.00.

Ordered: that the tax in Waccamaw Township listed to Dr. S. A. Smith for the years 1927, 1929, 1930, 1931, 1932, 1933, and 1939 be cancelled, and the tax collector be granted a refund therefor, and that the 100 acre tract listed to Dr. S. A. Smith in Waccamaw Township for year 1943 be listed in 1944 as 40 acres with a valuation of \$240 as there has heretofore been an error in both valuation and number of acres.
