In the discussion taken up in this joint meeting the matter of having the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners named as a member of the Executive Committee of the Board of Trustees of the hospital was approved and recommended. Approval also was voiced to present to the Board of County Commissioners for their files a copy of an annual audit/ of the Columbus County Hospital that they might have a progressive knowledge of the financial condition of the Hospital.

The following Order is recorded as of December 5, 1944:




The Following order is recorded as of December 5, 1944:
