

REQUEST FOR ADDITION

TO

STATE MAINTAINED COUNTY ROAD SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the attached petition has been filed with the Board of County Commissioners of the county of Columbus requesting that the above described road, the location of which has been indicated in red on the attached map, be added to the system of county roads now maintained by the State Highway and Public Works Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, after careful investigation, deems the proposed addition of said road to the County Road System and its maintenance by the State Highway and Public Works Commission necessary to adequately serve the citizens of said county.

NOW, THEREFORE, the State Highway and Public Works Commission is requested to take said road over for maintenance and the addition of said road and revisions in location deemed necessary by the State Highway and Public Works Commission are hereby approved.

The certain portion of unpaved road in Western Prong township, measuring 1 1/2 to 2 Miles, on the road running from Mt. Olive Northwardly to Bladenboro be increased in width to that portion of the road on each side of the narrow stretch.

Ordered: that J.A. Rooks Jr, be allowed to settle taxes due listed for years 1933 and 1935 in the name of R.D. Benson, Whiteville Township, at par plus 6% and one-half of Court Cost.

Ordered: that 1945 taxes listed to N.B. Chesnutt, Whiteville Township, be allowed settled at par due to his having been in the armed forces during said year.

Ordered: that property listed to Ralph FormyDuval, Ranson Township, be listed in 1947 at \$2000.00 Valuation.

Minutes of preceeding meetings read and approved.

Ordered that Rosier Williams be sold 2 hogs dressed at 574 pounds from the County Home at 25¢ per pound.

Ordered: that \$10,000 additional be appropriated to the Whiteville City Unit, Capital Outlay, 1946-47 appropriation to be charged in the amount of \$5,000 against said unit Capitol Outlay appropriation for 1947-48 and 1948-49 respectively.

Ordered: that the County's part of the 1946-47 Budget for the Health Department be approved in the amount of \$11,520.00.

Ordered: that the offices in the Court House be authorized closed on Labor Day, September 2nd, and that the next regular meeting of the Board be held Tuesday September 3rd, 1946.
