Mrs. Nabel Butler Townsend newly appointed Clerk of Superior Court tendered her bond in the amount of Ten Thousand (\$10,000) Dollars with The Fidelity and Casualty Company of New York as surety. Her bond was accepted and approved, all Commissioners being present and voting therefor.

Ordered: that S. Preston Douglas, Certified Public Accountant, be directed under contract now in force to make an audit and settlement of the account of D.L. Fuller, County Accountant be authorized to file application for approval of said Proposed Bonds with the Local Government Commission.
