Ordered: that letter be written to Dr. L.D. Baver, Director of N.C., Experiment Station, State College Station, Raleigh, N.C., recommending that an Experiment Station locate a sub-station in Columbus County to work on Fusarium wilt in tobacco.

Upon motion of Commissioner W.F. Floyd, seconded by Commissioner Bud Stephens, and by unanimous vote of all commissioners present, it is Ordered that there be and is hereby levied on all businesses within the County the maximum lien or privilege tax authorized by General Statute and that this be and is hereby levied a fee of \$4.00 for each Marriage Certificate issued within said County, all of which shall be collected by the proper officer and paid into the General fund of the County.
