The following business was transacted:

1. Beginning at S.P. Gore's Service Station southeast to S.P. Gore farm near the ford of Mooney Swamp. Approximately 5/10 mile.
2. Beginning at Carley Luton and leading to the Simmons place by Willie Nobles into the road leading into the road running from Joe Nobles to Perry Nobles. 3/4 Mile.
3. Beginning at L.H. High's farm on the Welches Creek Road and extends to the Welches Creek Cemetary, passing Liberty Hill School, Welches Creek Church and Love Grove Church for a distance of about 3.5 miles to John Try's store.
4. Road from Oddie Batten's Service Station to Joe High's old place, now owned by Dowless in Welches Creek Township, approximately 1 1/2 miles in length.
5. The following road hard-surfaced. Road known as the Peacock Road, west of Highway No. 74 for a distance of at least 2 miles.
6. 3/10 of a mile of road leading from Mrs. Jane Thompson's to Mr. Herbert Thompson's. This being a part of the old Whiteville to Conway road.
7. Beginning at Highway 76 and running through Old Enzor Farm via H.C. Enzor's and J.B. Enzor, Addie Shaw and John Shaw and connecting with Station maintained road near Tom Barnes. Road being approximately 2 miles long.
8. Leading from a point on the Mollie and Chad-bourn highway at H.E. Stanley's place to a point on the Mooney road at Arthur Watson's place over the lands of H.E. Stanley, Will Price, W.K. Todd, J.L. Hardee and Dillon Jolly. Approximately 2 miles.
9. To have laid out and constructed a public road leading from a point on the pole cat road at Earl Wrights farm over the lands of Earl Wright, Clara Bell Copeland to a point on the Old Whiteville and Conway road at Mill Branch Church. Approximately one-half mile.
10. Road begins at Willie McPherson's on the highway leading from the Tabor-Whiteville road to Beaverdam Church and runs about one mile South to a highway leading from Peacock to the road from Tabor Highway to Beaverdam Church; thence a road leading from said highway starting about 100 yards East and thence running to highway about a mile to the old Clarendon Road. Road will run from Willie McPherson's to the Tabor City Highway and old Clarendon road.
11. Beginning at a point about 7/8 mile westward from U.S. Highway No. 701, and about 11/16 miles westward of New Hope Church, runs south-

westerly and joins the Peacock about 1/4 mile northward of Beaverdam Swamp.

- 12. Certain road situated in Columbus County and reaching from Highway 701 to Peacock Road.
- 13. Beginning at a point on State Highway No. 130 at or near Clifton's Oyster Road, following the Simmons Bay Road to Reaves' Ferry

WHEREAS, the attached petition has been filed with the County Commissioners of the county of Columbus requesting that the above described road, the location of which has been indicated in red on the attached map, be added to the system of county roads now maintained by the State Highway and Public Works Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners after careful investigation, deems the proposed addition of said road to the County Road System and its maintenance by the State Highway and Public Works Commission necessary to adequately serve the citizens of said county.

NOW, THEREFORE, the State Highway and Public Works Commission is requested to take said road over for maintenance and the addition of said road and revisions in location deemed necessary by the State Highway and Public Works Commission are hereby approved.
