


1. Road in Chadbourn Township from Page Mill to go North through and by the Forham Place.
2. To build and construct a passable road along the right-of-way of the Atlantic Coast Line Railroad from Peacock Crossing to Dyson Crossing.
3. That certain piece of road about three quarters of a mile which leads off of the Evergreen-Cerro Gordo road near Emilyn Williamson and runs into the road leading from Edmond's Mill pond into State Highway #76.
4. Road from Vann Brown's to J. J. Hester's. This road would constitute a much needed link between the old Chadbourn road and N. C. highway No. 410.
5. To extend road now under construction from highway leading from highway 76 to Union Valley Church through the farms of Claude Bowen; Junior Fisher, W. C. Bowen, S. E. Pridgen, and Charles Pate, on through the lands of M. L. Tedder and Gordon Prevatte and Clarence Butler and connecting with highway that leads from the Sweetes Farm to the Smyrna and Chadbourn road near the home of Clarence Butler.
6. To work and improve the Stake road leading from Emerson through Grice to the hard surface highway between Chadbourn and Fair Bluff.
7. The road which leads from J. W. Reaves' house and Jones Crossroad to the Ramsey Ford road, in Bug Hill Township.
8. To build an all weather farm Commodity road leading from Highway 74 & 76 at Wooten's Motors, Inc., in Chadbourn through the Smyrna section and connect to the hard surface at White Crossroad.
9. Ransom Township. Road starting at Rawls Crossing of the old Lake road and runs in a northerly direction and intersects the Wilmington and Fayetteville highway at or near the point of the Late John Collins estate.

OF

STATE MAINTAINED COUNTY ROAD SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the attached petition has been filed with the Board of County Commissioners of the county of Columbus requesting that the above described road, the location of which has been indicated in red on the attached map, be added to the system of county roads now maintained by the State Highway and Public Works Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, after careful investigation, deems the proposed addition of said road to the County Road System and its maintenance by the State Highway and Public Works Commission necessary to adequately serve the citizens of said county.

NOW, THEREFORE, the State Highway and Public Works Commission is requested to take said road over for maintenance and the addition of said road and revisions in location deemed necessary by the State Highway and Public Works Commission are hereby approved.
