Ordered: that the report on audit as presented and made by S. Preston Douglas, Certified Public Accountant, on the accounts and records of the accounts and funds of the county for the period beginning July 1, 1947 and ending June 30, 1948 be accepted, and settlement for tax collections for 1947 and prior years be accepted as per audit.

Ordered: that the contract of Mr. S. Preston Douglas, Certified Public Accountant, to audit the county records for the year 1948-1949 be accepted.

Ordered: that the ^{floors of} living room, dining room, kitchen, hall, and bath room of the County Jail be covered with Armstrong Asphalt tile according to the bid of Todd's Furniture Co., and that the price not exceed that of said bid which is \$207.00.

Ordered: that W. D. Brooks be instructed to investigate and receive bids for revaluation of property.

Ordered: that John Henry Carter, Chadbourn Township, be given refund on 1948 taxes on \$ 1100 valuation to reduce household and kitchen furnishings valuation from \$ 1500. to \$ 400., the check to made in the amount of \$ 19.25 as the 1948 taxes have been paid in full.

Ordered: that the 1937 tax of Oster Fipps in South Williams Township be allowed paid at par.

Ordered: that Mrs. Bertha Stephens, Cerro Gordo Township, personal property valuation on 1948 taxes be reduced \$ 510 and tax collector be granted a refund to correct error in listing.
