The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that Ernest H. Cox, Bug Hill Township, tax for 1948 be allowed paid without late listing penalty and tax collector be granted a refund.

Ordered: that John Henry Carter, Chadbourn Township, be given refund on 1948 taxes on \$ 1100 valuation to reduce household and kitchen furnishings valuation from \$ 1500. to \$ 400., the check to made in the amount of \$ 19.25 as the 1948 taxes have been paid in full.

Ordered: that the 1937 tax of Oster Fipps in South Williams Township be allowed paid at par.

Ordered: that Mrs. Bertha Stephens, Cerro Gordo Township, personal property valuation on 1948 taxes be reduced \$ 510 and tax collector be granted a refund to correct error in listing.

Ordered: that 1947 taxes of E. L. Wright, Whiteville Township, be segregated so that Mrs. Sadie Elixson may pay the taxes on the real estate for 1947.

Ordered: that Mrs. Jack Williamson, R-1, Whiteville, N. C., be appointed to serve as member of Columbus County Library Board.

Ordered: that The First National Bank of Whiteville, N. C. shall place in escrow an additional \$ 100,000 to cover Columbus County deposits in said bank.

Ordered: that beginning Jan. 1, 1949, no show nor carnival will be allowed to show in Columbus County without paying county license.

Ordered: that M. C. Tyree, Whiteville Township, 1948 tax valuation on car be reduced from \$ 1700 to \$ 200 as it was listed as a 1947 and should have been 1937 model, and tax collector be granted refund on \$ 1500 tax valuation reduction.

Ordered: that L. E. Inman, Chadbourn Township, be granted a refund on the tax on \$ 2000.00 valuation for 1948, this refund to be given to the tax collector , as there was an error made in the valuation.

Ordered: that tax listed to Paul Nance, Tatum Township, for 1948 be corrected and the tax collector given a refund of the tax on \$ 1800 valuation to correct error in valuation.

Ordered: that the 1948 tax valuation listed in the name of Judson Moore, Jr., Ransom Township, be reduced from \$ 2702 to \$ 941 as this was listed through error by the tax lister and that the tax collector be granted refund on \$ 1761 valuation - amount \$ 30.82.

Ordered: that the 1946 tax listed in the name of George D. Graham, Waccamaw Township, be cancelled and tax collector be granted refund as this was double listed - receipt # 460.

Ordered: that John Monroe Nance, Cerro Gordo Township,
