The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that discontinuance of road near Fireway as recommended by the State Highway and Public Works Commission not be approved and that the State be requested to improve this road.

Ordered: that the tax valuation of J. Edward Jenrette, Waccamaw Township, be reduced \$ 7,820 thus reducing house and lot from \$ 6495 to \$ 3,000; 3 trucks from \$ 1,690 to \$ 1,365; and the saw mill from \$ 5,000 to \$ 1,000; and the tax collector be granted a refund in the amount of \$ 136.85.

Ordered: that Hattie King, Tabor City, be allowed \$ 5.00 immediate relief.

Ordered: that Albert Strickland, Cerro Gordo, be allowed \$10.00 immediate relief.

Ordered: that the Court House be closed and employees given a one day holiday on both Armistice Day, Nov. 11 and Thanksgiving Day, Nov. 25.

Ordered: that Britt Hardware Co., Chadbourn Township be allowed a reduction of \$ 2,000 on 1948 inventory valuation and that tax collector be given a refund for \$ 35.00.

Ordered: that Scott Motor Co., Fair Bluff Township, 1948 inventory valuation be reduced \$ 1,000.00 and tax collector be granted refund for \$17.50.

Ordered: that the tax of G. Eugene Jackson in Chadbourn Township for the years 1945, 1946, and 1947, be segregated and all personal property and poll tax thereon be cancelled and the tax collector granted a refund therefor as this personal property and poll tax was entered thereon in error, and Horace G. Leanord allowed to pay the tax on the real estate valuation for the said years thereby releasing this real estate from the lien of such taxes.
