

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office March 6, 1950, it being first Monday.

The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that Whiteville City Schools be allowed to transfer \$3,000 from Vocational Education Fund to General Current Expense Fund as authorized by Board of Trustees of Whiteville City School Unit in regular meeting July 12, 1949.

Ordered: that A. W. Williamson be reappointed to the Welfare Board for a term of three years.

Ordered: that Forney Gore be placed in the County Boarding Home temporarily at the expense of the County until investigation can be made of his property.

Ordered: that the 1948 and 1949 tax in Waccamaw Township listed to Mrs. J. C. Nye be segregated so that the lien for tax on this 17 acres Home and Farm tract listed for each of said years at a value of \$275 may be released upon the payment of the tax on \$275 valuation, plus penalties for each of said years by W. B. Hobbs, the present owner of said land.

Ordered: that the 1949 tax listed in the name of Mrs. J. W. Ingram, Whiteville Township, be cancelled and tax collector be granted release as this was listed through error.

Ordered: that the 1949 tax value listed in the name of Mrs. J. W. Ingram, Whiteville Township, be reduced from \$183 to \$83 as this was listed through error and that the tax collector be granted release on \$100 valuation.

Ordered: that the tax listed in the name of Dupree D. Cox, Bug Hill Township, for the years 1945 and 1946 be segregated so that Retha Mae Soles may pay on \$100 valuation and this be reduced from the tax lien.

Ordered: that the taxes in Lees Township listed to W. J. Simmons for the years 1948 and 1949 be cancelled and the tax collector given a release for same as this property is double listed to Henry Dubois for 1948 and to B. A. Harlowe for 1949.

ROAD PETITIONS

1. Township - Tatum
Road runs from Highway 242 to 242 and is known as the Old Bladenboro Road.
2. Whiteville Township.
Road runs from U S 701 via F. G. Walker, C. W. Horne, Tallie Horne to end of pavement at Peacock Road and is known as The Slippery Log Road.
3. Chadbourn Township.
Road runs from Wilson W. Hayes, Estate to Carlie Tuton's Farm and is known as Road not named.
4. Tatum Township.
Road leading from Mt. Olive Baptist Church, beginning at the Silverspoon Road, leading and connecting with the Whiteville and Lumberton highway.
5. Williams Township .
Road runs from John Long's Filling Station to Mooney Swamp and is known as The Mooney Road.
6. Chadbourn Township.
Road runs from Peacock Road to Chadbourn - Tabor City Road and is known as White Road.
7. Bolton Township.
Road runs from Smith Chapel Church to Marvin Beaty.
8. Bughill Township.
Road runs from Tabor City and Pireway Road to Old Guide Road and is known as Neighborhood Road.
9. Tatum Township.
Road leading from Williamson Cross Road by way of Macedonia Church to # 74 Highway at Boardman.
10. Bug Hill Township.
Road runs from Public road Old Pireway to Community Cemetery and is known as Gore's Avenue.
11. Establish a bridge or a State owned Ferry across the Cape Fear River near Acme, N. C. in Ransom Township, Columbus County, and to improve and construct such roads as are necessary to connect Acme, N. C. via said bridge or ferry across the Cape Fear River.
12. Rebuild existing road from U. S. Highway # 74 at Corinth Church, for a distance of approximately one and one half miles, about North, to the Silverspoon Road at the Porter place.
