The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that Olive Ward, R-3, Tabor City, be allowed \$5.00 present relief and the Welfare Dept. be asked to investigate the case for Aid To The Blind Assistance.

Ordered: that David Mills, Bolton, be allowed \$5.00 present relief and the Welfare Dept, be asked to investigate the case.

Ordered: that Viola Carter, Chadbourn, be allowed \$5.00 for present relief and \$5.00 on May 1st, and the Welfare Dept. be asked to investigate and put on Old Age Assistance immediately.

REQUEST FOR ADDITION
OF
STATE MAINTAINED COUNTY ROAD SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the attached petition has been filed with the Board of County Commissioners of the county of Columbus requesting that the above described road, the location of which has been indicated in red on the attached map, be added to the system of county roads now maintained by the State Highway and Public Works Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, after careful investigation, deems the proposed addition of said road to the County Road System and its maintenance by the State Highway and Public Works Commission necessary to adequately serve the citizens of said county.

NOW, THEREFORE, the State Highway and Public Works Commission is requested to take said road over for maintenance and the addition of said road and revisions in locations deemed necessary by the State Highway and Public Works Commission are hereby approved.
