The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that the County appropriate \$450.00 for rent for the P.M.A. Office and receive funds from the Town Commissioners and Whiteville Board of Trade in the amount of \$450.00 and pay rent at the rate of \$100.00 per month for the last 9 months of the fiscal year, 1950-1951.

Ordered: that the Board of Commissioners call for an election for the issuance of Bonds in the amount of \$56,000.00 for the County's part on a \$200,000.00 extension to the Columbus County Hospital, said election to be held along with the General Election in November. It is further ordered that E. K. Proctor, County Attorney, be instructed to advise the Bonding Attorneys to set up machinery for said election.

Ordered: that the Courthouse be closed on Sept. 4, 1950, in observance of Labor Day and the regular monthly meeting of the Commissioners to be held on Wednesday, September 6th, 1950.

On motion the meeting was adjourned until Sept. 6, 1950.
