

The Board of Commissioners for the County of Columbus, met in adjourned regular session at the County Courthouse in Whiteville, North Carolina, the regular place of meeting, at 10:30 o'clock, A.M., October 30, 1950.

After calling the meeting to order and after the Clerk had called the roll the members of the Board of Commissioners discussed the forthcoming special bond election to be held on November 7, 1950 upon the question of issuing \$56,000 County Hospital bonds of the County of Columbus, and particularly the fact that it now appears that the funds which had been expected from the State (to be used, together with Federal funds and the bond proceeds to erect and equip an addition to the Columbus County Hospital) might not be available.

It was therefore deemed advisable to repeal the bond order and the resolution calling the election.

Thereupon Commissioner W. F. Floyd introduced the following order which was read:

AN ORDER REPEALING AN ORDER FINALLY PASSED OCTOBER 2, 1950, ENTITLED: "AN ORDER AUTHORIZING \$56,000 COUNTY HOSPITAL BONDS".

BE IT ORDERED AND RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners for the County of Columbus:

1. That an order finally passed October 2, 1950 entitled: "AN ORDER AUTHORIZING \$56,000 COUNTY HOSPITAL BONDS" be and the same is hereby repealed.
2. That This order shall take effect upon its passage.

Thereupon, upon motion of Commissioner W. F. Floyd, seconded by Commissioner D. H. Jordan, the foregoing order entitled: "AN ORDER REPEALING AN ORDER FINALLY PASSED OCTOBER 2, 1950 ENTITLED: 'AN ORDER AUTHORIZING \$56,000 COUNTY HOSPITAL BONDS '" was passed by the following vote:
