

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office October 1, 1951, it being first Monday.

Ordered: that L. C. Bonkemeyer, Sr., be relieved of \$17.30 late listing penalty in Chadbourn Township and \$10.24 in Tatum's Township and tax collector be given release as this was due to Mr. Bonkemeyer being in hospital out of state during Jan. 1951.

Ordered: that the county farm be leased for a period of five years beginning Dec. 1, 1951.

Ordered: that advertisement be run in News Reporter relative to lease of county farm stating rent payable yearly - 50% on Dec. 1st and balance when crop is sold and that sealed bids will be received until 12:00 Noon first Monday in November, 1951.

Ordered: that W. A. Weir, Tax Collector, be authorized to mail letters to all persons known to have failed to list automobiles warning them that a list would be turned over to Grand Jury for investigation after 10 days.

Ordered: that the taxes for 1925 and 1926 listed in Ransom Township to W. H. Moore Estate be cancelled and that all penalties and court cost on W. H. Moore Estate taxes in Ransom Township for the years 1937 and prior years be released upon the payment of all taxes of W. H. Moore Estate in Ransom Township.

Ordered: that the penalties and interest on 1937 and all prior years listed to D. C. Fussell in Williams Township be released and the tax collector is directed to permit the payment of such years without collecting any penalties, interest or court costs, providing all the remainder of the taxes of D. C. Fussell in Williams Township are paid.

Ordered: that the tax collector be given a release for \$6.75 on the tax of Eddie Nathaniel Graham, South Williams Township, 1950 taxes.

Ordered: that the 1950 personal tax listed in the name of Taft Edge, Fair Bluff Township be cancelled and tax collector be given a release as this tax was double listed.

Ordered: that the 1951 poll tax listed in the name of Ed M. Carter, South Williams Township be cancelled and tax collector be given release as this man went in the armed forces 7-1-50 and is still in service.

Ordered: that the tax collector be given a release on the valuation of \$720 for the 1951 tax of Earl Coleman, Tatum Township, as the automobile listed to him was valued to high.

Ordered: that the tax collector be given a release on a valuation of \$900 on the 1951 taxes listed to Mrs. Ophelia Edwards, Whiteville Township, as her automobile was valued wrong.

Ordered: that the tax collector be given a release on the valuation of \$1,040 on 1951 taxes listed to Edwin Wright, South Williams Township, as this car was double listed to Linwood Wright.

Ordered: that a cash refund be given to Garland Williams in the amount of \$200 as poll tax was charged against him for Whiteville and Chadbourn Township.

Ordered: that the tax collector be given a release for the ¹⁹⁵¹tax on the valuation of \$670 on the taxes listed to E. E. Hughes, Bolton Township, as this was added to his tax through error.

Ordered: that W. D. Stone, Loris, S. C., be appointed as local registrar for Bug Hill Township.

Ordered: that W. F. Floyd be allowed to sign for county accountant for school checks during week of vacation for Alice S. Burns, County Accountant, It is further ordered that Waccamaw Bank & Trust Co. be notified date of checks to bear this signature.
