The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that Henry Wyche, Chairman of Courthouse Addition Committee, be empowered to award contract to Holloway, Weber, & Reaves, Architects, to draw plans and specifications for building.

Ordered: that courthouse be closed Monday through Wednesday for Christmas holidays.

Ordered: that tax valuation of J. T. Biddle be reduced to \$4,165, and tax collector be given release on \$2,000 valuation for 1951 taxes.

Ordered: that courthouse be closed Jan. 1, 1952, for New Years Day.

Ordered: that regular pay roll checks be released Dec. 17th.

Ordered: that office of county attorney and tax attorney be combined appointing R. B. Mallard at a salary of \$260.00 per month, effective Jan. 1, 1952.

Ordered: that \$25.00 be paid Whiteville Merchants Association on donation for decorating courthouse for Christmas.

Ordered: that \$10.00 be allowed to Caswell Training School for Christmas Santa Claus.

Ordered: that Glen Glisson be appointed tax lister for Ransom Township to serve in the place of Mr. Lennon who rejected the appointment.

Ordered: that the 1951 poll tax for Lee Williams, Lees Township, be cancelled and tax collector be given release as this man died Sept. 1950.

Ordered: that the 1950 personal tax in the amount of \$3.00 for Richard O. Graham, Chadbourn Township, be cancelled and tax collector be given release as this man is dead and his people have left this state.

Ordered: that the 1949 and 1951 tax listed in the name of Esta Mae McLelland, Whiteville Township, be cancelled and tax collector be given release as this tax was double listed for these years.

Ordered: that Floyd Hammond be given a cash refund in the amount of \$3.15 due to the fact that his taxes were double listed for 1950 and both taxes have been paid. (Fair Bluff Township)

NOW THEREFORE, the State Highway and Public Works Commission is requested to take said road over for maintenance and the addition of said road and revisions in location deemed necessary by the State Highway and Public Works Commission are hereby approved.
