Ordered: that workers in office of Tax Supervisor be paid at the rate of \$5.00 per day.

Ordered: that A. B. Dawsey be allowed credit of \$5.00 per month or \$60.00 per year on rent of county farm tenant house for light service.

Ordered: that Sheriff, Fingerprint Expert, and Deputies in Sheriff's department be allowed an increase of \$50.00 per month travel expense for remainder of fiscal year ending June 30th, 1952, during Period of emergency of Ku Klux Klan.

Request for Addition  
To  
State Maintained County Road System

WHEREAS, the attached petitioned has been filed with the Board of County Commissioners of the county of Columbus requesting that the above described road, the location of which has been indicated in red on the attached map, be added to the system of county roads now maintained by the State Highway and Public Works Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, after careful investigation, deems the proposed addition of said road to the County Road System, and its maintenance by the State Highway and Public Works Commission necessary to adequately serve the citizens of said county.

NOW, THEREFORE, the State Highway and Public Works Commission is requested to take said road over for maintenance and the addition of said road and revisions in location deemed necessary by the State Highway and Public Works Commission are hereby approved.

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Ordered: that a cash refund of \$200 be given to David L. George Sr., for poll tax that was charged to him through error as he is 64 years of age (Whiteville Township)

Ordered: that William Fowler, South Williams Township, be permanently exempt from poll tax as he is a disabled war veteran.

Ordered: that the valuation for Mildred S. Howell, Bolton Township, be reduced \$1,500.

Ordered: that the 1925 through 1951 taxes in the name of Senia Williamson, Tatum Township, be cancelled and tax collector be given release as this was couble listed for these years.

Ordered that the 1948 poll tax listed in the name of Curtis Fowler, Williams Township, be cancelled and tax collector be given a release as this man was a resident of South Carolina at that time.

Ordered: that Curtis Fowler, Williams Township, be given a cash refund of \$2.00 for poll tax that he paid through error for 1951 as he was a resident of South Carolina.
